Position statement on the Sale of Pigs to Small Scale Producers
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Approved by the CASV-ACVP Board of Directors on June 25, 2019

Small scale pig production is becoming more prevalent across Canada. It is important these producers are registered with their provincial pork organization and are aware of current disease risks, including foreign animal diseases. Therefore, a few steps must be taken by the seller to ensure they remain compliant with current PigTrace Canada requirements for traceability.

- Only sell pigs to premises that:
 - a. have a Premise Identification (PID) number; and
 - b. are registered with their provincial pork organization .
- All pig sales and/or movement must be reported to PigTrace Canada within seven days of sale; including the purchaser's name, email, phone number and PID.
- Ask the provincial pork organization for any educational or news material to be sent with the purchased pig(s); e.g. ASF fact sheet, Canadian or provincial health reports.
